Rocky Flats Citizens Advisory Board Recommendation 94-1

to the United States Department of Energy

Regarding a Decision to Proceed to Stage II of the National Conversion Pilot Project

Approved July 7, 1994

The Rocky Flats Citizens Advisory Board (RFCAB) advises the Department of Energy that the RFCAB has no objection to the proposed National Conversion Pilot Project (NCPP) Stage II scope of work to include the cleanup of buildings, declassification, NEPA process, process verification, operational repairs, market analysis, and continued public outreach, if this is a priority for DOE and if using the funding available for Stage II will not decrease funding available for other projects.

Although not directly an issue during Stage I decision making, many of the stakeholder members of the RFCAB are concerned with many aspects of the proposed NCPP Stage III.

Other RFCAB members have expressed enthusiasm and endorsement of the entire project.

The RFCAB expects to be provided adequate opportunity to advise DOE on Stage II decisions.

The Rocky Flats Citizens Advisory Board is a community advisory group that reviews and provides recommendations on cleanup plans for Rocky Flats, a former nuclear weapons plant outside of Denver, Colorado.
